- ✧ Make Otter Creek fun! If the timer adds too much pressure, practice without it. ☺

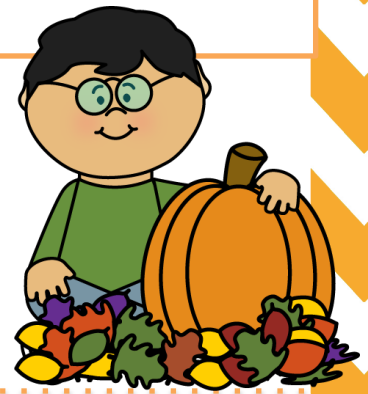
