

- o Mass will begin promptly at 10:00 a.m.
- o All students who have returned the RSVP form will have a part in the Mass, you are responsible for practicing with them at home.
- o Seating arrangements are as follows:
 - o Find your seat by banner
 - o 1 pew for family-student sits at the end, close to the aisle
 - o Extra room in the back or side chapel
- o Communion will be received by 2nd grade students first, then family and friends
- o Reception—Hosted by 3rd grade in the Parish Hall





Girls:


- ♦ White dress (any length)
